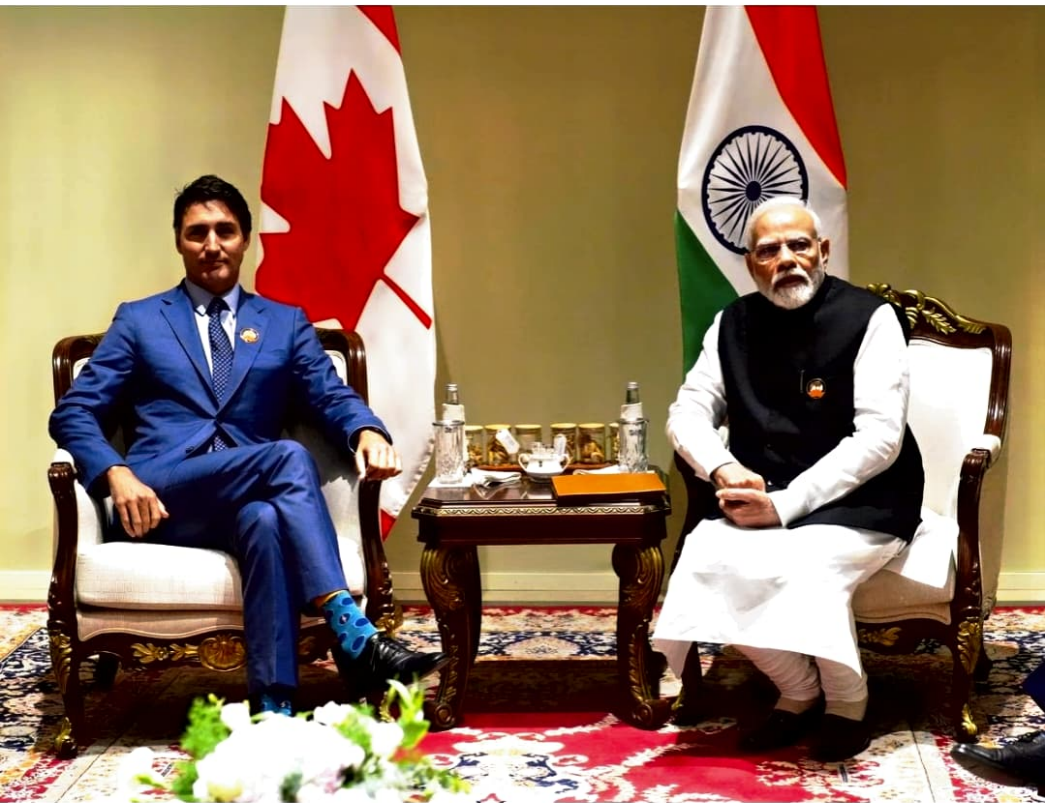


After U.S., U.K., Australia, Five eyes member New Zealand too criticises India on order expelling Canadian diplomats

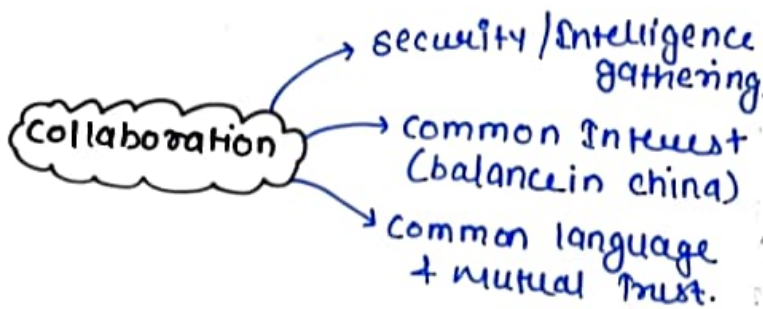

- Alliance of Australia, Canada, New Zealand, UK and the US.
- These nation collaboration on intelligence matters, sharing information to protect national interest.

→ Origin:- Back to World war-II when UK and US decide to share intelligence

↳ It began as Britain-USA (BRUSA) agreement, later UK-USA (UKUSA) Agreement, with Canada join in 1949 & Newz. + Australia in 1956.
